RECORD OF ACHIEVEMENT - NOVICE DOG OF THE YEAR

Rules for entry:

- 1) The year for novice dogs started immediately after our Birthday Competition Show
- 2) The dog should have started the year as a novice or grade 1 competitor, and must not have attended the club before April 2008.
- 3) Points are awarded for all competition entries, clear rounds, places, and for gaining Bronze, Silver or Gold awards at the club.
- 4) All record of achievement forms should be completed and returned within 14 days of the 2010 Birthday Competition Show.
- 5) You can not enter Novice Dog of the Year and Dog of the Year. Enter either one or the other.
- 6) **At the end of this newsletter there is the Record of Achievement form for you to complete if you wish your dog to be entered for the year ending March 2010.**
- 7) The Novice Dog of the Year competition will begin again after the March Birthday competition show. All ungraded dogs joining the club since April 2009 will be eligible.

DOG OF THE YEAR (DOTY) COMPETITION

Now were into 2010 the Dog of the year competition has now started. This will be open to all dogs that compete no matter what training class you run in. It is completely optional to enter. Points will be awarded for places and clear rounds at competitions. The dog with the most points at the end of the year will win the Dog of the Year Award.

We were going to split the DOTY into Small, Medium and Large Dogs but we've not had the numbers to do this so it will be just one league.

If you've not already entered the DOTY competition, then you can do at anytime this year but I will only backdate the results for one month.

In each Newsletter I will report the current league standings so you can see how you are doing.

I have attached the rules and points form to this newsletter. Please either e-mail me your points or give me your points at club (giving me the information which is on the points form).

Dog of The Year Rules

1. Open to all NDDAC members who compete at any level.
2. Any height of Dog may enter
3. The Dog of the Year competition shall be split into Small, Med and Large Dog of the year – due to class sizes in the different height categories
4. Points can be gained from any KC or unaffiliated show (i.e. Winter Dog Vegas, EMDAC etc)
5. Inter-club matches, Winter Leagues, Pay on the Day, Pairs, Team or Brace classes will not count towards the league.
6. Points from the following 'Special' classes will count towards points for the league: Helter Skelter, Take Your Own Line, Snooker, Time, Fault & Out, Beat The Clock, Gamblers, Power & Speed, Touch and Go, Allsorts/Any Size Jumping, 'Steeplechase' style jumping classes.
7. Championship classes will count towards the league for points but only the agility and jumping qualifying rounds (not the final, which is entry restricted).
8. In all categories points for more than one dog cannot be added together.
9. Points can still be gained if the dog is run by another handler.
10. Points will be awarded as follows: For AGILITY classes - 1st place 30 points to 20th place 11 points. Unplaced clear round 6 points. For JUMPING/SPECIAL classes - 1st place 25 points to 20th place 6 points. Unplaced clear round 3 points.
11. Points will only be awarded for places if a rosette is actually awarded.
12. It is the owners' responsibility to send in their points via e-mail, post or you can hand them to me at club.
13. Points must be claimed within one calendar month of the show taking place.
14. In the event of a draw, the dog with the highest overall placings in the year will win.
15. Final results at the end of the year must be received by the end of January 2011.
16. The Dog of the Year competition will run from 1st January to 31st December of that year (i.e. Jan 2010 to Dec 2010)
17. Presentations will be at either the NDDAC birthday party or the NDDAC Summer agility festival (to be decided by the committee).
